

# Questions and Answers

Q: When will the water be turned on?

A: The water will be turned on Friday, May 15, 2020.

Q: When will the bath houses be open?

A: The bath houses will be open when it is safe, which is to be determined by local and State authorities, and the CDC protocols.

Q: What is the plan for the honey wagon start up?

A: The honey wagon pumping will begin during Phase Two, which could be as early as two weeks, however is to be determined at this time. The dump station is currently available along with the fresh water station.

Q: What is considered a second residence?

A: Any member that considers LHV a second residence is allowed to overnight camp on their site at their discretion.

Q: How many persons can ride on a golf cart?

A: The maximum capacity per golf cart is a single household unit.

Q: Will my grass be cut if I am unable to attend LHV due to COVID-19?

A: Yes, LHV is mowing all sites including sites with red tape, when the grass exceeds 3 inches tall.

Q: When should you report your results of self-screening?

A: All members are subject to report their results of self-screening if required, and must report your results to the LHV office when you present symptoms of COVID-19.
